Case study: Singapore



- **The Government of Singapore has launched an initiative**, called SGClean, with the collaboration of KPMG.
- **SGClean establishes the protocols to be followed by the different sectors, including** the hotel, restaurant, retail, transport, etc. **sectors**, to ensure the safe use of their public facilities.
- These **protocols include** procedures, checklists, guidelines, computer graphics and other materials
- These protocols cover **employees, customers and suppliers**.
- **KPMG verifies the existence and proper functioning of these protocols**.
- Currently, **more than 5,000 establishments** have been certified.

One of the fundamental impacts that COVID19 will have, once the crisis is over, will be **the lack of confidence** when carrying out normal activities involving social contact

The only way to reactivate economic activity, once the confinement is over, is **to recover confidence**, which will allow us to return to the new normal as soon as possible.

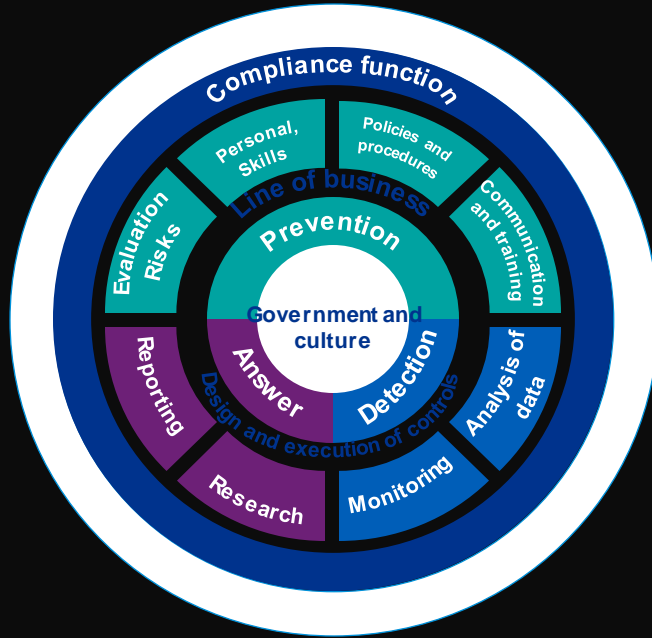
In this new normal, it is reasonable to think, that some special measures of hygiene and cleanliness and of social distancing will last in a more relaxed way than as they are being carried out at present.

Testing



PCR:

- It is based on the direct detection of the virus' genetic material (RNA)
- Identifies infected patients shortly after infection is established
- Low number of false negatives

SEROLOGICAL TEST:

- It is based on the detection of antibodies
- It allows the identification of infected patients from 5 days onwards.
- High number of false negatives.



7 days before

A serological test will be carried out on all persons who are going to take part in the shooting.



2 days before

A PCR will be performed on all persons who are not immunized according to the results of the serological test



A PCR test will be conducted every 7 days for the main actors.
